Dress Code Guidelines

Gentlemen:

Dear Brothers in Christ,

Please make sure that the gift of modesty is exercised and that you reflect and exude the respect that you have for our Lord.

The following type of clothing/attire will NOT be acceptable;

T-shirts, short-sleeved shirts, sandals, athletic shoes, sneakers, shorts, jeans, logos/big patterns on any article of clothing including shoes.

Anyone with long hair must also make sure that **ALL** hair be off of your forehead.

The following type of clothing/attire is acceptable;

Dress slacks, long sleeved button-up shirts, dress shoes, dress socks, a tie.

Preferable items include: white dress shirt and red tie.

Anyone who is wearing something that is inappropriate or offensive and/or dressed in a manner which does not honor the above guidelines will be asked to address the issue immediately and will be sent home to do so if necessary. This serves as a warning for everyone.

Thank you for keeping to the dress code and setting a good example.

Dress Code Guidelines

Ladies:

Dear Sisters in Christ,

Please make sure that the gift of modesty is exercised and that you reflect and exude the respect that you have for our Lord.

The following type of clothing/attire will NOT be acceptable;

Dresses that are more than 2-3 inches above the knee, tightly fitting dresses/skirts, mini skirt or similar styles, low cut styles, spaghetti straps, strapless tops/dresses, heels/platforms over 2.5 inches, exaggerated makeup and any clothing that is of thin material and can be potentially “see-through”.

In addition, the following will NOT be acceptable: T-shirts, sandals, athletic shoes, sneakers, shorts, jeans, logos/big patterns on any article of clothing including shoes.

Please be sure to style hair so that is off of your forehead.

The following type of clothing/attire is acceptable;

Dresses, blouses, skirts, slacks, cardigans, and simple makeup are highly preferred. A good rule to apply: *If you're questioning it, then you probably shouldn't wear it!*

Preferable items include: white and red colors

Anyone who is wearing something that is inappropriate or offensive and/or dressed in a manner which does not honor the above guidelines will be asked to address the issue immediately and will be sent home to do so if necessary. This serves as a warning for everyone.
